Aspiration



- Deliver quality teaching of Religious Education.

Indicators of Success

- Teachers engage in a process of revitalization of Religious Education year level scope and sequences ensuring they include short-term planning cycles.
- Teachers use precious pedagogy to plan and teach religious education. E.g. 'Strategies that Maximize Impact' and 'Reading and Writing Connection – Arts as a Bridge'.
- Teachers engage in moderation of Religious Education Assessment, to ensure the achievement standard is met.
- Staff, students and families are engaged in opportunities to be actively involved in the life of the Bulimba Parish as well as school social justice initiatives.
- A Catholic Perspective is included in all Health Curriculum, HASS and English.
- Wellbeing Week continues to build as part of our school culture each term.



Excellent Learning & Teaching

Aspiration

Grow engagement, progress, achievement and wellbeing for each student.

Strategies

- Advance student progress and achievement by improving literacy teaching and practice with targeted teaching of vocabulary and spelling.
- Use the high yield strategies of data walls, learning walks and talks, and review and response cycles to monitor the impact of teaching and inform planning.
- Provide resourcing, professional support and development for the use of effective and expected teaching practices.
- Accelerate literacy learning through targeted support in response to learning data.
- A whole school approach to promoting and responding to student attendance.

Indicators of Success

- Students have reached benchmarks and targets in literacy with improvements in vocabulary and spelling.
- Expected and Effective Practices are deeply understood, implemented and embedded within classroom practice.
- Teachers engage in short-term planning and teaching cycles in the subject of English using the context text model.
- Teachers use Precision Pedagogy such as 'Maximising Impact Strategies' and 'Reading and Writing Connection – Arts as a Bridge' to enhance short term planning cycles.
- There is a common language of learning amongst staff, students and parents.
- Student work is examined regularly to improve practice and inform teaching.
- Our school learning dispositions inform focused and regular discussion around learning goals and expectations for each student.
- Student attendance is at 92%.

Aspiration 1

Build sustainability through people and capability with a renewed focus on the core purpose Sts Peter and Paul's School.

Strategies

- Support continuous improvement and growth at individual and team level through professional learning, goal setting, co-planning and co-teaching, and consistent application of the effective and expected practices.
- Continue the external partnerships within the Bulimba, Cannon Hill and Carina Collaborative to build teacher capacity.
- Collaboratively redevelop Sts Peter and Paul's Vision, Mission and Values Statement in consultation with; staff and parents.

Indicators of Success

- A growth mindset underpins beliefs about teaching and learning, where pedagogical norms are practiced within all teaching and learning environments.
- Trust is evident within professional relationships.
- Rich and diverse external resources have been used to build teacher and school officer capacity.
- Opportunities will be provided for Professional dialogue – staff will engage in research-based conversations with colleagues on best practice.
- By the end of 2019 a draft Vision, Mission and Values Statement will be developed, articulating an intense common purpose.
